

Terms and Nomination Conditions for Vendor Challenge

The Vendor Challenge will be made up of 3 section- Dry Working, Time trial and Cattle Work.

There will be a winner of each section and an overall winner based on the culmination of points.

Scoring system

Working Section: Out of 100

Cattle Section: Out of 100

Time Trail: will be deducted from the overall score

All rider must be a member of ABCRA.

All people entering the challenge will do so at their own risk, and will be required to sign a waiver, the Great Southern Yearling Sale will not accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

The Great Southern Yearling Sale reserve the right to refuse or withdraw any entry/entries without having to assign a reason.

Complaints/Protests- The Judges decision will be final. Competitor or exhibitor may lodge a complaint, in writing to the Great Southern Yearling Sale, within 30 Minutes of the completion of the event. This must be accompanied by a fee of \$100 and is refundable if the protest is upheld.

All stallions must display a green identification disc on bridles. Stallion and Colts are only permitted to be handled and ridden by an adult, 18 years and over.

Entry fees are separate to the Sale nominations, and are non refundable.

All horses must be ridden in a **snaffle bit**.

Dress Code- Jeans, collared shirt and tie

Registered ASH OR QH- All Horse must be a registered Australian Stock Horse or Quarter Horse. You do not have to be the registered owner of the horse in the challenge.

Sale Horses- Each Sale entry = 1 Horse entry into the Challenge. E.g. 3 entries into the Sale you will receive 3 entries into the Challenge. Every Entry must be with a different horse.

Rider Eligibility- The Rider must be the registered owner of the sale horse. In relation to memberships involving more than one individual (i.e., a partnership, a family group, a company or corporation) any member listed under these memberships will be eligible to enter the Challenge, Proof of such memberships must be supplied upon nomination.

Non-transferable Entries- Challenge entries are not transferable, and you cannot nominate a rider to ride on your behalf.
